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# Leveraging new digital technology to drive reading engagement

In Higher Education, the rise of new technologies is leading to rapidly changing student learning behaviours. A “Netflix-style experience for education” was reported as an increasing expectation during a recent Times Higher Education and Perlego Roundtable for UK HE senior leaders. Students expect easy, on demand access to course materials.

The proliferation of artificial intelligence usage makes it a strategic priority for institutions to ensure students are supported to use these tools effectively, both in their studies and for future employment. Yet universities report feeling unprepared to meet these evolving needs in the age of AI.

How can institutions deliver in this area and embrace the opportunities presented by new technology, whilst ensuring academic integrity is upheld? In this case study, Perlego (“Spotify for textbooks”) and voices from HE will explore how AI can be leveraged to diversify learning material, increase reading, and improve student engagement.

A key challenge in preparing students to become independent learners is guiding them to critically evaluate resources and seek diverse perspectives. The number of different systems and tools can be overwhelming, and a risk of using AI to speed up this process can be a lack of academically rigorous material:

“When you ask the LLM ‘can you give me the reference’ it’s not a real journal or real book.”

“The issue with Google Scholar, for example, is you’re going to get titles and abstracts, not chapters. It has potential to be overwhelming as well, because if you did search in text through books, that’s going to get too much. Who knows if that would be useful.”

# Harnessing AI to boost reading with diverse material

When preparing students to become independent learners against a backdrop of AI, it's essential to ensure they're supported to critically evaluate resources and access diverse perspectives. How can institutions enable students to use these tools effectively to source learning material, and can AI provide valuable data around reading engagement?

To address these challenges, Perlego launched the Smart Search tool in 2024, developed in consultation with HE and publisher partners. It enables deep search within a text beyond titles and synopsis, surfacing only the most relevant extracts from 1 million+ quality books. 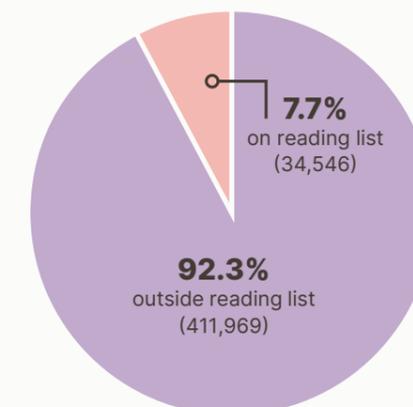

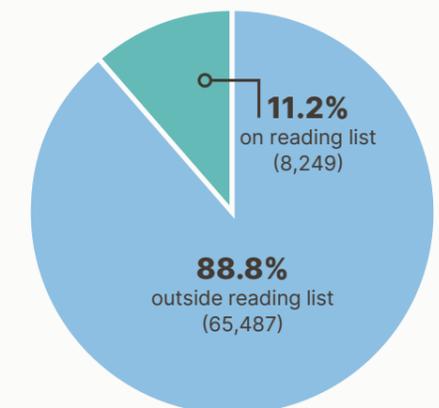

Our unlimited access model, combined with the Smart Search tool's ability to surface a range of diverse extracts, allows students to search beyond their reading lists without barriers. Data from two recent flagship partnerships in the UK reveals around 90% of books opened and hours read are beyond the reading list:

Rather than artificial intelligence being exclusively viewed as a tool that challenges academic integrity, it is also a means of expanding critical thinking around resources. Educators can use AI tools in the classroom to improve students' literacy skills, whilst helping to equip them with new research methods:

"AI Researcher is something that when I demonstrate it to students, they always think it's quite amazing. We're using that in a lot of the classes. I'll use it as a study example, and imagine we're trying to build information for our essay assessment. [...] I would use the AI researcher to ask a direct question, and then I show students the type of materials coming out. I think that's a great tool that's been very useful to a lot of my students, in order to amass information quite quickly and effectively."

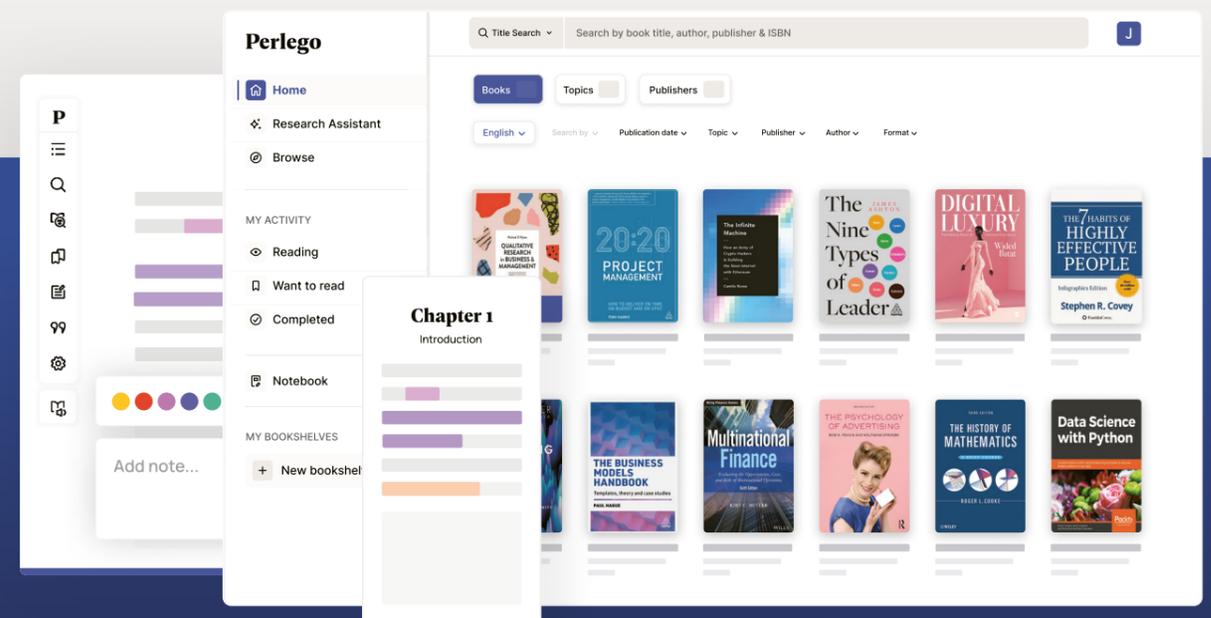
